

2nd WOMEN IN ANTITRUST BRAZIL BOOK

CALL FOR PAPERS

I. PRESENTATION

The 2nd Women in Antitrust Brazil Book, as well as the first one, aims to foster women's academic production and, with that purpose, it will feature articles divided into three major antitrust areas:

- i. Economic concentration
- ii. Anticompetitive conducts
- iii. Competition policy and correlated themes

With those categories as reference, we invite the female community to contribute to the discussion of those subjects through the submission of unpublished works.

The selected articles will be included in the 2nd Women in Antitrust Book, which will be launched, initially, in the International Seminar on Competition Law, organized by the Brazilian Institute of Studies in Competition, Consumer Relations and International Trade Law - IBRAC¹.

II. TARGET PUBLIC

In line with the values of the Women in Antitrust group, aimed at approximating women who dedicate themselves to the study of competition law, only submissions by female authors will be accepted, in order to encourage and give prominence to women's academic participation.

There is no requirement of a minimum degree for the authors.

III. PUBLICATION FORMAT

The accepted papers will be published in digital format.

IV. DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSIONS

The texts to be submitted under this call for papers must be sent until July 4, 2019, under penalty of not being examined. **The deadline for submissions will not be extended.**

¹ This year, the place and date for the International Seminar on Competition Law, which usually occurs at the end of October, are not yet defined. However, it is known that the seminar will take place between the end of October and the beginning of November. As soon as the Organizing Committee has more information about the book launch, the authors will be informed.

V. CONFLICT OF INTERESTS AND RESEARCH FINANCING

In the paper submission, the authors are responsible for recognizing and disclosing any conflict of interests that may have influenced the writing of the article, and such conflicts can be of personal, commercial, political, academic and financial nature.

In case the research is funded, the funding source should be indicated in a footnote at the beginning of the text.

VI. PUBLICATION RULES

Papers in co-authorship will be accepted, respecting the limit of 3 (three) authors and observing the antitrust theme (see item *I. Presentation*).

The papers must present a centralized title, with all capitalized words and in the language in which the paper was written, followed by the title in English, as well as an abstract in the language of the paper and another in English, of up to 500 (five hundred) characters, followed by the keywords (from 3 to 5). At the end of the text, there must be a list of references consulted.

The papers should be written according to the following rules:

- a) Page size: A4;
- b) Text size: minimum of 15 (fifteen) and maximum of 20 (twenty) pages, excluding the bibliographic references;
- c) Margins: 2 cm for all margins;
- d) Body text font: Times New Roman, normal, size 11,5, without space between lines and paragraphs. For direct quotes with more than 3 lines, the font must be size 11;
- e) Footnote font: Times New Roman, normal, size 10, single spacing (before and after: 0 pt);
- f) The chapters must be numbered in Arabic standard;
- g) The titles/chapters should not have automatic numbering, and should not be inserted in an automatic index;
- h) The highlights must be made in italics, as well as the words in foreign language;
- i) The quotes must follow the formal standards recommended by the Brazilian Association of Technical Rules (ABNT) in NBR 10520, in author-date style;
- j) The quotes of legal decisions must contain, in this order: the court of origin of the case, the ruling court, the type of proceeding, the case number, the date of judgment and the date of publication.

The spelling and grammar revision, as well as the observance of the publication rules set forth herein and of those featured in the ABNT rules, will be under the authors' responsibility.

IMPORTANT NOTE: WIA encourages the candidates to, as much as possible, highlight other women's scientific and technical production while writing their papers.

VII. ORIGINALITY AND ELIGIBLE LANGUAGES

The Scientific Committee will only analyze unpublished articles and may return the paper to the authors with suggestions for changes. If the requested alterations are not met, the Organizing Commission may reject the paper.

Only texts in Portuguese, English and Spanish will be accepted.

Articles submitted must not be in simultaneous evaluation process for publication in other journals.

VIII. DOCUMENT SUBMISSION

The papers should be sent **without identification** (under penalty of not being analyzed) to the e-mail address bookwia@gmail.com in PDF and DOC formats.

In addition to the files containing the paper, the authors should send to bookwia@gmail.com a third file (see attached model) in DOC format, with their identification data in the following order:

- a) name (how the author wants to be identified in the book – back cover, index; choose only one name format and let us know how we can abbreviate your name on the cover if necessary);
- b) passport number;
- c) brief biography to be included in the book if the article is accepted (profession, degrees, and institutions that conferred the degrees).
- d) telephone number;
- e) e-mail address.

ATTENTION: in order to ensure an impartial review, the papers should not contain the authors' identification.

IX. ARTICLE EVALUATION

The articles will be evaluated following the double blind review method, that is, they will be reviewed anonymously by at least two members of the Scientific Committee. If

the results of the evaluation diverge – in other words, if one evaluator votes for the publication, and another for the rejection of the article –, a third evaluator will be responsible for the tiebreaker.

In case of conditional acceptance of the paper, that is, with the need for changes, the author(s) will be responsible for making the requested changes, under penalty of having the paper rejected by the Organizing Committee.

Failure to send the revised article to the Organizing Committee within the specified period will result in the rejection of the work.

X. COPYRIGHT LAW

The content of the texts are of the authors' exclusive responsibility. The publication of the articles will be conditioned to the sending of the originality declaration and of the copyright transfer statement, authorizing the publication in the WIA book. The referred documents will be returned to the authors with the express acceptance.

XI. IMPORTANT DATES

February 28, 2019: publication of the call for papers for the 2nd Women in Antitrust Brazil Book;

June 4, 2019: deadline for article submission;

July 25, 2019: disclosure of results;

***End of October/beginning of November of 2019:** estimated launching date.
